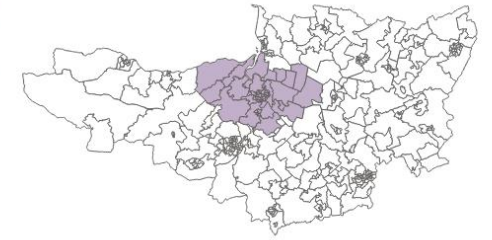
The document is intended to help PCNs identify priorities within their own area based on data and information about their own areas, registered patients and residents.

MAP



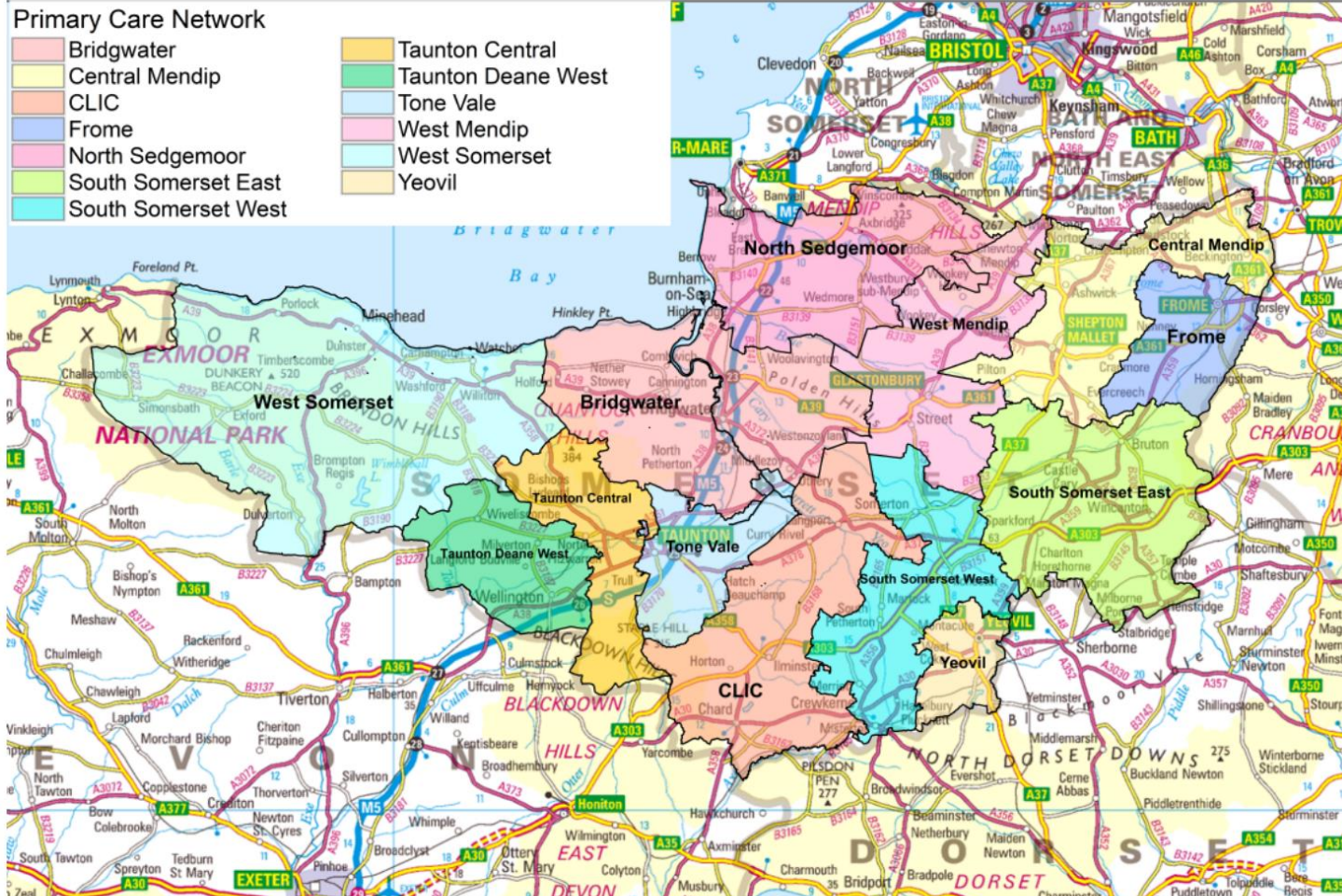
